## <u>Guidelines for implementation of Mid-Day Meal Programme in the</u> areas affected by drought during 2012 (Kharif)

Mid-day meal will be provided to the students during summer vacation in the areas which are formally notified by the State Govt. as drought affected. The following guidelines shall be followed meticulously while implementing the Programme.

- 1. The students of Primary, Upper Primary and NCLP schools are the beneficiaries under the scheme.
- 2. They shall be provided hot cooked noon meal as per their entitlement. In other words, a Primary student is entitled to ration cost of ₹ 3.61 and rice of 100 gms per day. Similarly, an Upper Primary and NCLP student is entitled to ration cost ₹5.39 and 150 gms of rice per day.
- 3. The weekly menu prescribed for normal schools days is applicable for summer vacation.
- 4. Mid-day meal shall be provided on all days of the summer vacation except Sundays.
- 5. All Primary, Upper Primary and NCLP schools shall remain open on all days of the summer vacation except Sundays. Roaster arrangement has to be made by the concerned DI of Schools. Sub-Inspector of Schools of the concerned drought affected area shall ensure effective implementation of the programme.
- 6. Cook-cum-helpers engaged for the programme in the schools will work during the summer vacation.
- 7. Fortnightly progress report is to be submitted.
