Sub: Abandonment of practice of operating multiple Bank Accounts under one scheme.

Sir,

It has come to my notice that despite of earlier instructions, multiple bank accounts have been maintained in violation of OGFR Rules to keep the funds under different schemes at the level of Directorates as well as at the District level.

The recent case of embezzlement of project fund in DPC, SSA, Bolangir through fake and fraudulent bank accounts is an eye opener for operating multiple bank accounts under one scheme.

With the introduction of Central Plan Scheme Monitoring System, it has become obligatory on the part of the Project authorities to link the bank accounts with the CPSMS web portal. It is therefore mandatory to maintain one single bank account instead of multiple bank accounts under one particular scheme in order to enable the linkage of bank accounts to CPSMS portal.

Moreover, FD in their guidelines clearly emphasized for e-transfer of funds to accounts of the beneficiaries.
