Sub:- Allocation of foodgrains under National Programme of Mid-Day-Meal in Primary & Upper primary schools (MDMS) for the period of 1st quarter for the financial year 2013-14 (April to June'2013).


Madam/ Sir,

With reference to the subject cited above, I am directed to intimate that the Govt. of India have communicated allocation of foodgrains (Rice) for the 1st quarter (April to June 2013) of 2013-14 in respect of the State under Mid-Day-Meal Programme for Primary & Upper Primary classes.

You may lift the stock of rice under Mid-Day-Meal Programme in accordance with the quota allocated to your district from the FCI depots to which your district has been tagged, starting from 1st day of the month preceding the allocation quarter and upto 25th of the last month of the allocation quarter. The lifting and utilization figures in the prescribed proforma may be furnished to this office regularly in the 1st week of every succeeding month.

You are further, requested to start lifting the quota of foodgrains to be supplied by FCI which should be of best average quality. The allocated quota may be lifted without fail to ensure full utilization.


